CLARIFICATION

Not reaching the maximum number of entries established in the regulations (12 teams qualified directly to the final phase), the criterion to qualify according to the regulations will be to use the previous world ranking that includes 12 countries (World Junior Championship Castellon 2019) to arrange the remaining places:

- Male category: Spain joins directly the final phase.
- Female category: by order, Spain, Portugal, Chile and Uruguay take the positions 8 to 11.

National teams delegation:

Each national team (male or female) will consist on the following:

Minimum 6 players, 1 coach and 1 federative member:

2 players U14, 2 players U16 and 2 players U18.

Maximum 12 players and 2 coaches and 1 federative member:

4 players U14, 4 players U16 and 4 players U18.

Note: Any player may be lined up, in national team's competition, in any category if his age allows it (Example: U14 may play in U16 or U18).





NATIONAL TEAMS DRESS CODE

Players of the same team must use the same colors and refrain from using logos of other Continental or International Associations.

In the event that teams in the same match ear the same color, the higher ranked team will have the preference and the lower ranked team MUST change to another color.

All teams must wear at least two uniforms of different colors.
